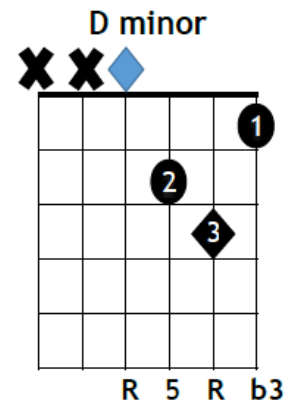
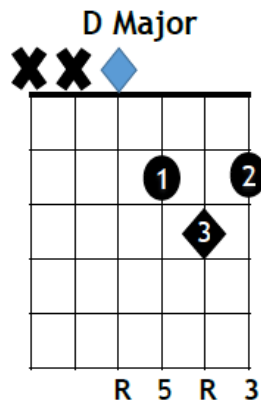
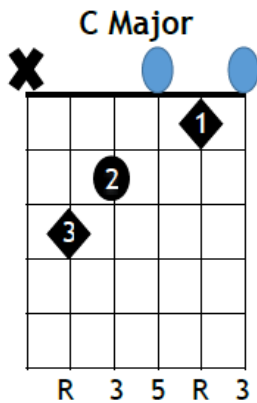
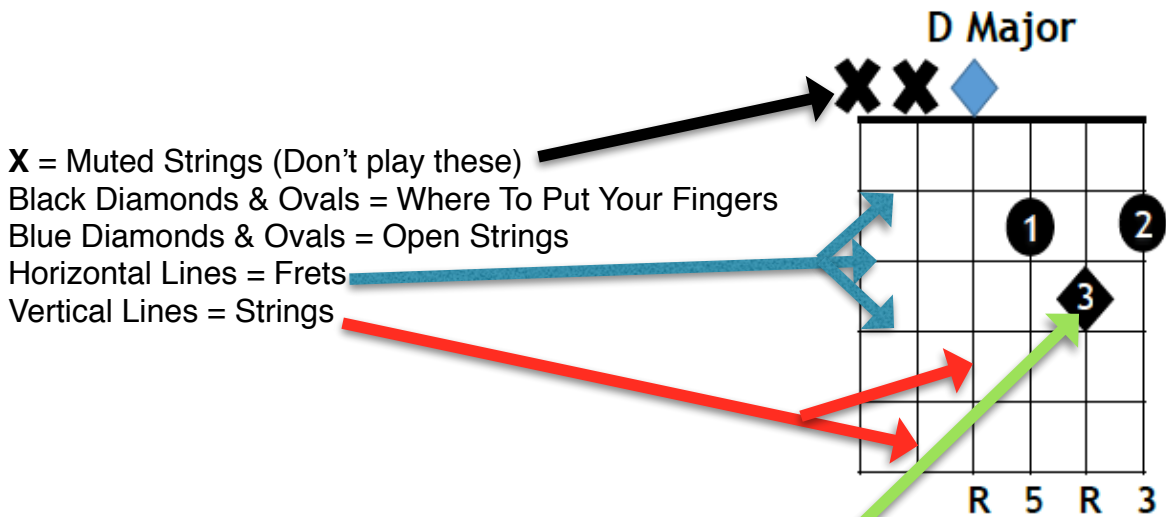


How To Read Chord Charts



Look how the vertical guitar placed next to the chart lines up below. This is exactly how the charts need to be visualized.



Large numbers inside chord dots are **fingering numbers** (NOT FRET NUMBERS):

- 1 = index (pointer) finger
- 2 = middle finger
- 3 = ring finger
- 4 = little (pinky) finger
- T = thumb (not used on this chart)

*Not all chord charts are written the same way, but in general you can expect them to look very similar to the examples you see in this document.
